APS Budget Season

Arlington Public Schools recently released their proposed 2025-26 budget. We are pleased to report that there are no cuts to Outdoor Lab programming at this time.

Regarding staffing, the current proposal maintains 6.75 FTEs (1 Supervisor, 1 Teacher/Coordinator, 1 Custodian, and 3.75 Lab Assistants).

On the transportation front, the budget now separately itemizes the cost of bus trips to the Outdoor Lab (\$99,775) from general transportation line items.

This is terrific news for Arlington students! We extend our sincere thanks to Superintendent Dr. Francisco Durán and the School Board for their continued support of outdoor education.

I also have really fond memories of being on the night hike and playing barred owl calls on a speaker into the woods. We were all waiting quietly and then a real owl called back to us and flew over the meadow we were in."
